2020 Kindness Challenge

LBCS is participating in the Great Kindness Challenge (<https://thegreatkindnesschallenge.com/>) January 27-31, 2020. This worldwide challenge, initiated by Kids for Peace Global (<https://kidsforpeaceglobal.org/>) and launched in 2008, has reached over 10 million students in nearly 20,000 schools. Kids for Peace is a non-profit youth organization whose mission is to create peace through youth leadership, community service, global friendship, and acts of kindness.

On Monday, January 27th your student's teacher will give each student an LBCS spirit shirt and challenge checklist. These checklists will provide "kindness" ideas but students can also write additional acts of kindness on the back of the sheet. Acts of kindness include things they do all day, including at home.

The goal is to see how many act of kindness students can collectively complete during the week.

- **Monday, January 27th: Be Open-Minded Day**
Students wear funky glasses or crazy hair.
- **Tuesday, January 28th: Serve Others Day**
Students wear camouflage or a super hero cape.
- **Wednesday, January 29th: Be InvincIBLE Day -**
Students wear "LBCS, A Kindness Zone" shirt
(handed out to each student on Monday).
- **Thursday, January 30th: Stand Up for One Another Day! -**
Students wear School Spirit Gear or Blue.
- **Friday, January 31st: No Excuses Day**
FREE DRESS DAY.

At the end of the week, we will collect all of the sheets and add up how many acts of kindness LBCS completed as a group!

PTC will continue the Kindness trend with activities and contests throughout the school year!
